

School-within-a-school information

Space for students

There's plenty of classroom space at Jan Reimer School to host Shauna May Seneca students and staff while their school building is under construction. Both schools will:

- open with fewer students to make sure it doesn't fill up too quickly while the community is still growing, and
- have closed boundaries, meaning only students from primary attendance areas can attend.

Classrooms for both schools will be grouped by grade throughout the building. This means there will be opportunities for collaboration and buddy classes between the two schools. Both schools will share common spaces, such as the art room, drama room, music room, gymnasium, library and learning commons.

Transportation for Shauna May Seneca School students

Edmonton Public Schools will provide [yellow bus](#) service to all Shauna May Seneca students who need it at no cost while they attend [Jan Reimer School](#).

Once Shauna May Seneca students move into their new school in January, yellow bus service will no longer be provided, as all students in the primary attendance area live within the walk boundary.

Before and after school care

Greenfield School Age Day Care Association will provide child care for *both* Jan Reimer and Shauna May Seneca students in Kindergarten to Grade 6.

Families with children registered at Shauna May Seneca School and attending Jan Reimer School until their building is ready in January 2018, can register for child care. The child care provider will have space available to support kindercare and out-of-school care for students from both schools. In January, child care services will continue through Greenfield School Age Day Care Association at both schools.

Moving to Shauna May Seneca School

Furniture for Shauna May Seneca School will be moved out over the winter break and won't disrupt classroom time. All schedules, classes and routines will be the same when classes resume at the new Shauna May Seneca School building on January 8, 2018.
